

2011 Summer Sailing Programs

The Boys and Girls Clubs of South San Luis Obispo County will be offering a series of aquatic classes open to the public for kids ages 10 to 16. Instruction will be held in the protected waters of Santa Margarita Lake. Summer sessions will begin in June and end in August. Instructors are certified by the American Sailing Association.

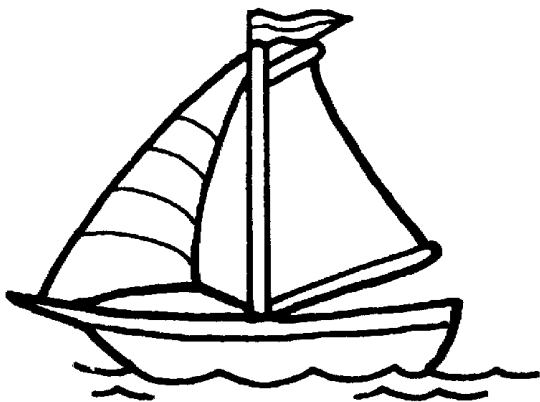
Courses offered at Santa Margarita Lake will consist of instruction in basic kayaking and sailing. (1/2 hr. classroom instruction; 2 1/2 hrs. on water per day)

Beginning Sailing: is a 4 day, 4 hour class and limited to 7 students (minimum # of student is 4). Students will acquire basic sailing knowledge, sailing terms, parts and functions of a sailboat, and rules of the water. Students will acquire boating skills such as proper use of personal floatation device, rigging of boats and knot tying. Prerequisite: Pass water proficiency evaluation.

Monday - Thursday: June 27-30, July 11-14, July 18-21 \$160

Intermediate Sailing: is a 4 day, 4 hour class and limited to 7 students (minimum # of students is 4). Students will build upon skills and boater knowledge acquired in the Beginning Sailing course. Students will spend more time on the water practicing tacking, jibbing, docking and launching. Curriculum will follow the American Sailing Association's "Basic Small Boat Sailing (ASA 110)".
